## **ORDINANCE NO. 2020-05**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE, KANSAS, BY ADDING A NEW SECTION, 14-1, PERTAINING TO THE COLLECTION OF VEGETATION BY THE CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE, KANSAS:

**Section 1.** That a new section, 14-1, is hereby created and added to the Code of Ordinances of the City of St. George, which shall read as follows:

## Section 14-1. Vegetation Collection.

The City may create a designated area for residents of the City of St. George, Kansas, and the City, to deposit grass clippings, branches, and leaves. The City may dispose of items deposited in the designated area by burning or any other lawful method. Non-residents of the City of St. George, Kansas are prohibited from depositing any item in the designated area. No person shall deposit any tire, metal, lumber, carpet, plastic, pallet, drywall, sawdust, furniture, appliances, railroad ties, demolition waste, household trash, construction waste, mattresses, varnished or painted wood, or any other similar items in the designated area. A sign shall be posted designating the area and listing the allowed and prohibited items. A violation of any provision of this Section is a misdemeanor offense to which the general penalty section (1-7) of this Code applies, except the Court shall impose a fine of at least \$250.00 for any violation of this Section.

<u>Section 2.</u> This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
