ORDINANCE NO. 2020-

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 32, ARTICLE III, SECTION 32-63 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE, KANSAS, PERTAINING TO PROHIBITED ACTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE, KANSAS:

Section 1. Amendment. That Section 32-63 of the Code of the City of St. George, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 32-63.

- (a) It shall be a violation of this article for any person to:
 - (1) Tamper, damage or meddle with any watermain, fire hydrant, electric line or any other water or electric equipment belonging to the city;
 - (2) Make any connection to the water or electric systems of the city without a written permit from the city;
 - (3) Reconnect service when it has been discontinued for nonpayment of a bill of service.
- (b) Any person who violates this section shall pay an administrative fee to the City of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00). In the alternative, the person may be referred to the City Attorney for prosecution in St. George Municipal Court and shall be subject to the penalties set forth in Section 1-7 of this Code.

<u>Section 2.</u> Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
