ORDINANCE NO. 2020 09

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ALCOHOLIC AND CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES IN ANY CITY PARK OR ON ANY OTHER CITY PROPERTY, AND ALLOWING FOR A WAIVER THEREOF BY THE GOVERNING BODY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE, KANSAS:

Section 1. Amendment. That a new section is hereby created, section 4-1, which shall be added to the St. George Code, and shall read as follows:

4-1. ALOCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN CITY PARKS. It shall be unlawful for any person to use, consume or possess on the premises of any park or other city property within the city any alcoholic liquor or cereal malt beverage, except by consent of the Council. Upon consent of the Council, the City Clerk shall issue a permit therefor.

<u>Section 2.</u> All ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed in so far as they conflict herewith.

<u>Section 3.</u> This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and shall be published in the official City newspaper.
