A proposal was put together by Benkendorf Trucking to bring in 16,500 cubic yards of fill dirt, provide rough grading for \$255,750 and remove storage sheds and concrete on the property and a tree for an additional \$5,000.00. Buildings shall have approved address numbers placed in a position to be plainly legible and visible from the street or road fronting the property. These numbers shall contrast with their background. Address numbers shall be Arabic numerals or alphabet letters. Numbers shall be not less than 4 inches (102 mm) in height with a minimum stroke width of .05 inch (12.7 mm)
