HIGHLIGHTS FROM CITY COUNCIL

September 8, 2022

- ◆ City Council unanimously passed Ordinance 2022-10 vacating a portion of the historic Fremont street within the City of St. George.
- ◆ *City Council unanimously passed Resolution 2022-05 to levy a property tax rate exceeding the revenue neutral rate.*
- ◆ *A 2023 Budget hearing was held. The City Council unanimously passed the 2023 budget*
- ◆ *Resolution 2022-06 was unanimously passed to create a special fund to receive, hold & disburse funds for development and improvement of Chapman Road.*

Did you know?

Buildings shall have approved address numbers placed in a position to be plainly legible and visible from the street or road fronting the property. These numbers shall contrast with their background. Address numbers shall be Arabic numerals or alphabet letters. Numbers shall be not less than 4 inches (102 mm) in height with a minimum stroke width of .05 inch (12.7 mm)
