CITY CODE FOR FIREWORKS

Sec. 22-8 Fireworks. (a) Discharge. It shall be unlawful for any persons to discharge or fire off any fireworks of any kind within this city, except on: July 1, from noon to 10:00 pm, July 2, from noon to 10:00 pm, July 3, from noon to midnight, July 4, from noon to 12:30 am July 5. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge fireworks on or at any city street within the corporate limits of the city,

\$6.00 per thousand gallons for water used from 1,001 to 5,000 gallons;

\$7.00 per thousand gallons for water used from 5,001 to 10,000 gallons;

\$8.00 per thousand gallons for water used from 10,001 gallons and above.
