HIGHLIGHTS FROM CITY COUNCIL

May 11, 2023

- ◆ Four new Ordinances were passed regarding changing water rates, regarding notice to be provided under City code, regarding regulating the use of campers and recreational vehicles as residences and prohibiting camping in public areas within the City, and temporarily permitting the public sale, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages for KAWnsas Fest.
- ◆ The City Attorney, Judge, Inspector, Clerk, Treasurer, and Chief of Police were all re-appointed.
- ◆ There were discussions held about sewer to Dara’s and water rates/agreement with Scenic Woods.

Flat Sewer—\$45.00 (unchanged)

Flat Water—\$ 39.95

\$3.00 per thousand gallons for water used from 1 to 1,000 gallons;

\$6.00 per thousand gallons for water used from 1,001 to 5,000 gallons;

\$7.00 per thousand gallons for water used from 5,001 to 10,000 gallons;

\$8.00 per thousand gallons for water used from 10,001 gallons and above.
