HIGHLIGHTS FROM CITY COUNCIL

October 12, 2023

- ◆ Judd McCormack updated the council with numbers that were given by BG Consultants for the cost for a new City Hall. With numbers still coming in high, he suggested that the Council look at other projects that need done and prioritize those first. The council would still like to see the land platted and Judd will reach out to BG Consultants to get that done.
- ◆ A discussion was held on the Dara's sewer project. The council will be provided with answers mid-November to start negotiation.
- ◆ The City Council approved the Bayer Construction bid for 2nd Street repairs
