# a. SECOND STREET MANHOLE REPAIRS AND THIRD STREET

Bayer Construction came back with the bid for these projects at \$33,525.00. Of this the City Council approve Mayor Debby Werth to spend up to \$10,000 for the manhole replacement. That came back at \$10650.00, the reminder is for the fix at third and grant.
