

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-11

AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY PERMITTING CERTAIN PUBLIC SALE, SERVICE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR IN THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE, KANSAS:

Section 1. Any individual or entity granted a Temporary Permit for a Special Event by the Alcoholic Beverage Control division of the Kansas Department of Revenue, to sell, serve or permit the consumption of alcoholic liquor in an area outside of the ordinarily licensed premises, is authorized by the City to sell, serve and permit the consumption of alcoholic liquor in such area designated in the Temporary Permit. All restrictions set forth in the Temporary Permit shall be followed by the licensee, including restrictions on the date(s) and times of such activities.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
