

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-08

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE “UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES,” EDITION OF 2022, WITH CERTAIN OMISSIONS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBERED 2021-14 UPOC, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE, KANSAS:

Section 1. INCORPORATING UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE.

There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of St. George, Kansas, that certain code known as the “Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities, 2022 Edition, prepared, and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, save and except such articles, sections, parts or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed. No fewer than three copies of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped “Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 2022-08,” with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted or changed clearly marked to show any such omission or change and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

Section 2. BARBED WIRE SECTION DELETED.

That Section 10.13 of said Uniform Public Offense Code is hereby declared to be omitted and deleted.

Section 3. REPEAL.

Ordinance No. 2021-14 UPO and all other ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
