ORDINANCE NO. 2022-11

AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY PERMITTING THE PUBLIC SALE, SERVICE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR IN THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE, KANSAS:

<u>Section 1.</u> In conjunction with the KAWnsas Fest 2022, the City authorizes the public sale, service and consumption of alcoholic liquor as limited by this ordinance: The public sale, service and consumption of alcoholic liquor is restricted as follows:

- 1. The effective date of this ordinance is limited to October 15, 2022;
- 2. The authorized times on such date are limited to the hours between 9:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.;
- 3. The permitted area within the City is limited to the St. George City Park, generally North of 1st St. and West of Lincoln Ave.

The public sale, service and consumption of alcoholic liquor is limited by the date, time and geography set forth above, and no public sale, service or consumption of alcoholic liquor shall be permitted at other times or in other areas. All other restrictions of the City related to alcoholic liquor and cereal malt beverage shall remain in full force and effect, except as temporarily amended by this ordinance. Only those individuals or entities in possession of a Temporary Permit for a Special Event by the Alcoholic Beverage Control division of the Kansas Department of Revenue, are authorized to sell, serve or permit the consumption of alcoholic liquor as authorized by this ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper and as limited by the provision therein.
